

English as a Second Language (ESL)

Classes are offered to anyone wanting to learn English. The focus is on conversation, reading, writing and survival English.

Eligibility

You must be 18 years of age to participate in any of our programs.

Cost

Currently, there is a \$10 registration fee for this program. It must be paid at the orientation session. It is recommended that you purchase a book when class starts (\$20). You will need to bring pens, pencils and paper to class.

Enrollment

You must come to the Adult Education and Training Department to sign up for the next available orientation session. All programs require completion of orientation and assessment in order to start classes.

Orientation

This is an opportunity for us to share information about the program and policies. We will also gather some information about you and your educational goals. All of this information is kept confidential and is used to design a program that meets your needs.

Assessment

In order to serve you better, you will be given an educational evaluation. This ensures appropriate class and schedule selection. If we are unable to accommodate your learning needs or schedule we will refer you to an appropriate provider.

Schedule

Morning classes meet on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and will start and end between 8:30 a.m. and 12 p.m. Evening classes meet on Monday and Wednesday <u>or</u> Tuesday and Thursday and will start and end between 5:15 p.m. and 9:15 p.m. <u>Your exact schedule will be determined at</u> the assessment session.
